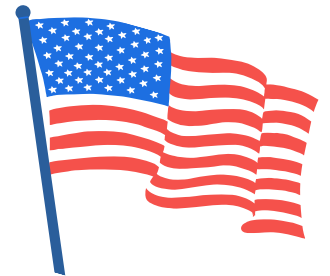

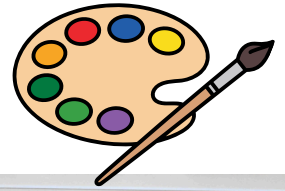

The 3rd Space and the Highland County Arts Council will host the 16th annual Artists' Weekend in Highland County on June 19 – 21, 2026. We have once again received special permission from local landowners and Hayfields, Virginia's newest state park, to paint at their scenic locations around the county so artists can capture the beauty of our area.

Check-in will begin on Thursday evening June 18, from 5:00 pm - 7:00 pm at Big Fish Cidery for the participating artists, followed by a special social hour at the cidery.

This is a time to meet old friends and new artists, complete paperwork and pick up instruction packets. Registration will also be available on Friday morning, June 19, from 8:00 am - 9:00 am at the Highland Center. Picnic lunches, catered by Claire's Cakes & Cafe, are available for pre-purchase and can be ordered through a link that will be emailed to you prior to the event.

The weekend will culminate in a Wet Paint show on Sunday the 21st from 1 pm - 3:00 pm and is open to the public where artists can display and sell paintings finished during the weekend.
